As the Director, Direct Access Program P. Antoine Broughton is responsible for all facets of planning and executing business networking events hosted by the Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization (OSDBU) to include the National Veteran Small Business Engagement. Mr. Broughton is the technical authority for OSDBU's strategic communications. Mr. Broughton's scope of authority includes planning, designing and executing initiatives to educate and help in the development of Veteran-Owned small businesses and other firms, to include providing information about the organization's services. Mr. Broughton represents OSDBU at a variety of inter-governmental and industry forums, performing briefings on a wide array of topics related to the advocacy and utilization of historically disadvantaged businesses in a variety of socioeconomic categories.

Mr. Broughton's assignment with OSDBU began in 2012 and he has held several leadership positions. Before his current position, Mr. Broughton served OSDBU as the Deputy Director Direct Access Program; Chief Verification and Executive Support; Determination Team Leader; and Executive Assistant to the Director, CVE.

Mr. Broughton is a Veteran of the United States Navy, having served 28-years on active duty. Mr. Broughton's military assignments included leading staffs which supported up to 10,000 Sailors and their families. The capstone of his Navy career entailed service as the Deputy Executive Assistant and Flag Secretary to the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Financial Management and Comptroller). Mr. Broughton's faithful active duty service included 13 years in the enlisted ranks followed by 15 years as a commissioned officer.

Mr. Broughton is a Doctor of Business Administration candidate. Mr. Broughton also earned a Master of Business Administration degree (with honors) and Bachelor of Science Degree Multi-Disciplinary Studies - Business Administration emphasis (Magna Cum Laude).
