

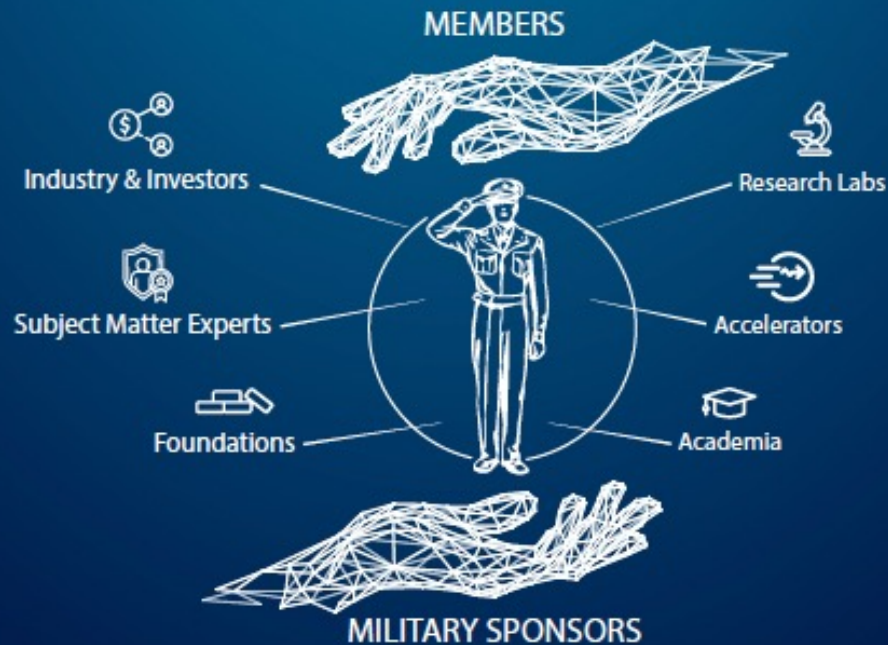

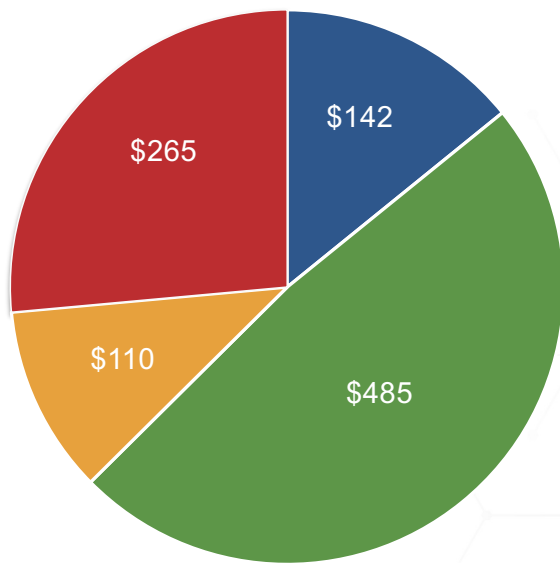
- Open a direct dialog between members and DoD

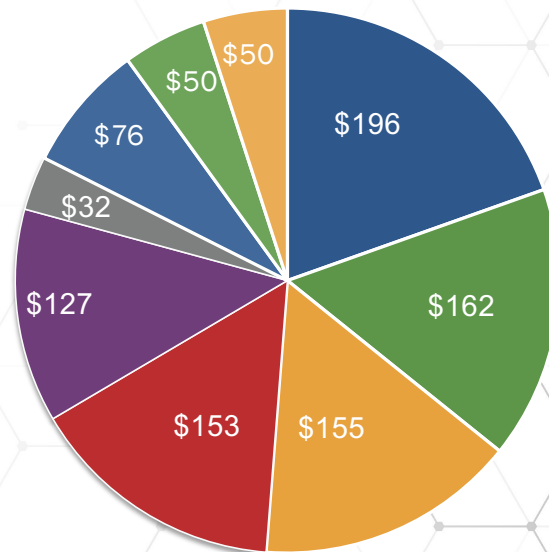


Awards (\$M)



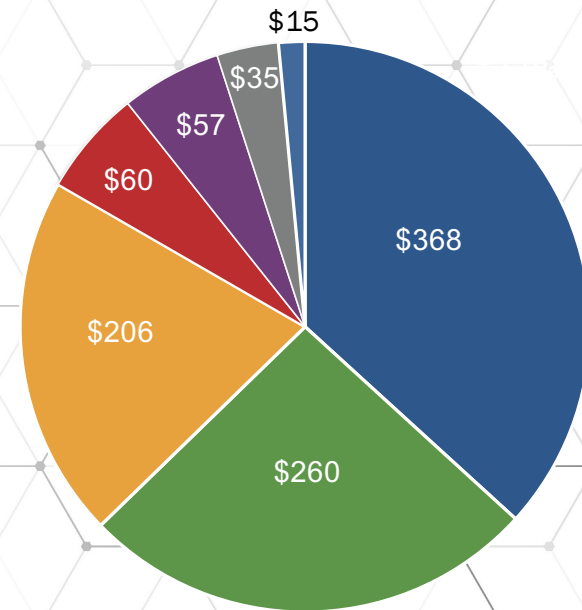

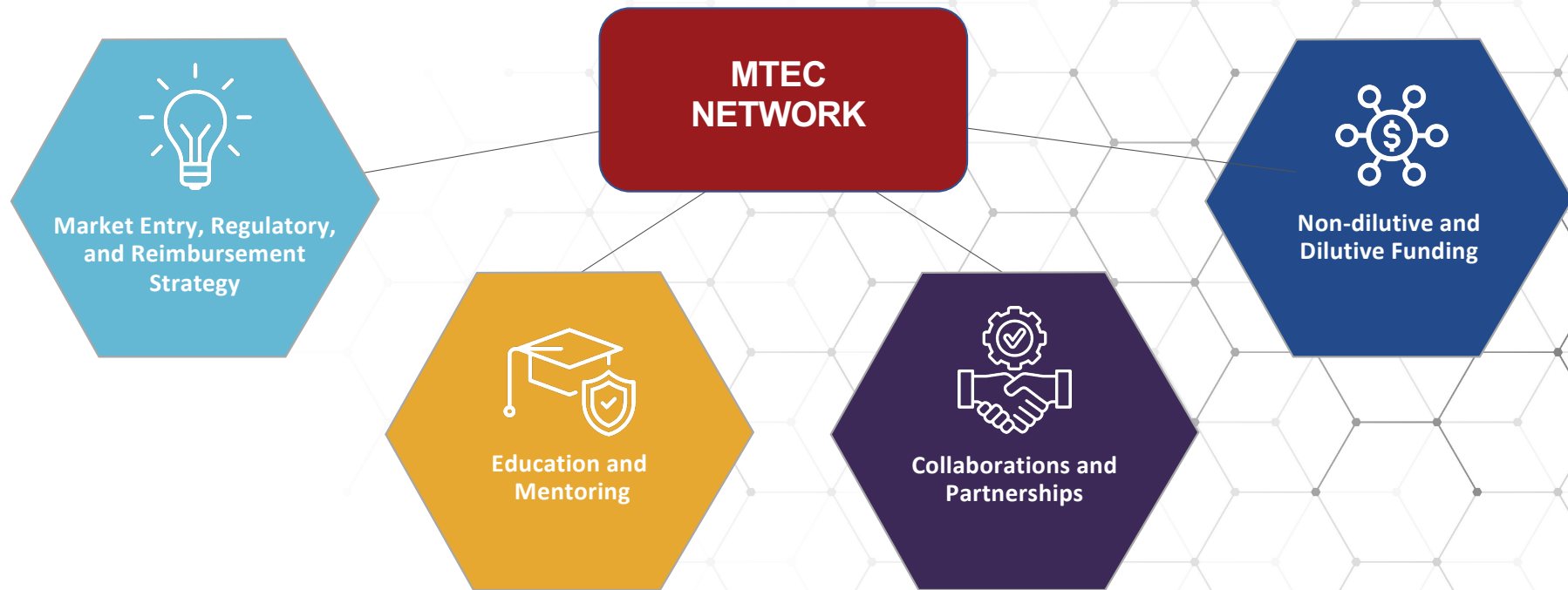
